I leave for the use and support of my wife Sarah after my just debts are paid and funeral expenses discharged which property I leave in the hands of my executors to give for the support of my wife as need requires while she remains my widow and at her death or marriage to another man the then remaining part of my Estate I distribute in the following manner one quarter part to John Hauss, my grand son, son of Simon Hauss and all the rest I give to my son William Hauss whom I appoint with my trusty friend James Court Esq. the executors of this my last will and testament I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul and every other former testaments, wills, legacies bequest and executors by me, any wise before named and confirming this my last will and testament, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21 day of August one thousand seven hundred and ninety five Signed Sealed and pronounced and declared by the said John Hauss as his last will and testament in the presence of us who in his presence and in the presence of each ^{have hereunto} other, subscribed our names. the words word witness are interlined before the making of this Instrument.
