Friederich Haas and wife Margaretha had among their ch:

- 1) Catharina, b. 28 Feb 1766 - sp: David Gardiner and (--) Wendel (NY City Lutheran Chbk).
- 2) Johann Georg, bpt. 19 June 1768 - sp: Francis Marbel, Mis Rohr (NY City Lutheran Chbk).
- 3) Elisabetha, b. 2 Oct 1770 - sp: Francis Marbel and wife Mary Elisabeth; and the Widow Rohr (NY City Lutheran Chbk).

JACOB HAAS

Jacob Haas was in Lot #14 called Vette Berg in Beekman's Prec^t with a first date of 1 May 1743 (Rent Book kept by Henry Beekman, 1740 - 1768, p. 124).

JOHANNES HAAS

Johannes Haas and wife Sarah had among their issue:

- 1) Wilhelm, b. 24 Feb 1751 - sp: David Roeter and Anna Huet (NY City Lutheran Chbk).

A Johann Haas and wife went to parts unknown in 1740 (?) from Oberweiler (*Auswanderung aus der Rheinpfalz und dem Saarland*, by Werner Hacker, #5328).

JOHANN HENRICH HAAS

Joh. Hinrich Haas and Anna Catharina Jongen (md. 11 July) had their first communions in 1736 (NY City Lutheran Chbk).

GEORG HABACHER

George Habacher, aged 44, b. Germany, butcher, was noted on a muster roll of Capt. John Vischer's Company taken in the City and County of Albany in May of 1762 (*Muster Rolls of New York Provincial Troops 1755 - 1764*, Edward F. De Lancey, editor, p. 438).

ANDREAS HABENER

Andrew Habener, Lutheran of NY City, cordwainer, was naturalized 29 July 1762 (Scott & Stryker-Rodda, p. 32).
