I have written up notes on my Census + Parish Register searches. I scoured around in the 51 Census for the kids who were "out at home".

I have enclosed the Dd/Gwen marriage details.

The LF Abergwesin had no baptism for David as I have written, — non conformist most probably because the children were not baptised in the parish Church. I would have to see if there are any Abergwesin Non-conf Registers deposited.

There may be some info for the Pritchard and Thomas families. They are at the National Library.

There may be some scope to squeeze out another generation or two — the BIS go back to 1714 for Alanddewi A. — Gwen's parish and if David's parents can be found the LF Abergwesin Registers go back as far.

So there is a chance for a little more.

The money you sent covered the marriage  
from the Index and the research so far.

Note Seeing the family with a Margaret Pritchard in the 61 Census, prompted me to look for her in the 51 Census. She was there but a widow and on her own.

I searched the 41 Census + found her at 1365/3/5/4 at Argoed, Hanafanfaur. I am glad I did because it gave.

Maybe this John is a brother to David (puty he was dead before we could find out where he born in the 51 Census) and Margaret went to stay with David + Gwen — look at the name patterns — it mirrors D + G's a little

So I looked for David + Gwen's Baptisms.

No luck in L'Ehangel Abergwesin for David.

However in Llundain Abergwesin There was a Gwen baptised 28 March 1790 (date about right) daughter of David Thomas (no mother given); However I looked on and David Thomas baptised Aug 4-4-1793 and Rees 26-3-1797 mother Catherine; There was a marriage for David Thomas and Catherine Jones

(at LFA Abergwesin) 1 Dec 1774. From 1774 would have to be checked to see if there were children for during the contd (4)

period up to Gwen's baptism.

There may be wills to confirm these families

But it definitely looks as if they were nonconformist because they did not baptise any children in the parish church. There may be registers for the district but I have not checked yet.
