To Thomas Moulton 10 acres for an house lott, ab &c; 10 acres of fresh meadow of 4 acres by bro: Howards & some more of Driffords house lott, & the rest elsewhere &c; 15 acres of planting ground, 10 of it adjoining to his house lott, & the rest in the East field &c.

To Richard Swains 10 acres for an house lott, ab &c; 12 acres of fresh meadow of 6 1/2 acres beyond the new pasture 4, & 15 acres of planting ground in the East South field &c.

To Robert Dicks 10 acres for an house lott, ab &c; 12 acres of fresh meadow of 7 acres by the Mill River (beyond the bridge) & the remaining nears Cougel wigwam &c; 15 acres of planting ground in the South field &c.

To Robert Saunders 10 acres for an house lott, ab &c; 10 acres of it by bro: Jones & the rest nears Cougel wigwam &c; 15 acres of planting ground in the South field &c.

On the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> mo: 1640.

- 1. Bro: Crofse is chosen (by votes in writing) to goe Deputie for y<sup>e</sup> Co<sup>o</sup> to the next generall Co<sup>o</sup> to be begun at Boston on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the 8<sup>th</sup> month (next), in case he be timely recovered of his y<sup>e</sup>sent infirmity &c.
  - 2. J<sup>th</sup> Agreed & granted, that M<sup>r</sup> Bartholm<sup>e</sup> in G<sup>r</sup>iffso, Tho: Jones, W<sup>illm</sup> Easton, W<sup>illm</sup> Palmer, John Moulton, Thomas Moulton & W<sup>illm</sup> Wakefield, shall have seven acres apiece more added unto what is already appointed them, in the East field (ab pts of their larger lotts formerly granted); & also of James Jarvis, Richard Swaine, Robt Curth, & Robt Sawnderson shall have ten acres apiece added to thers formerly appointed, in the South field (ab pts also of their larger allotment); & like wise y<sup>e</sup> (in that South field) Richard Knight shall have five & twenty acres (ab pts of his hundred) & W<sup>illm</sup> Leonard & W<sup>illm</sup> Fuller ten acres apiece added to their fiftens &c. All to be speedily layd forth by the mesageors &c.
- At the direction of J<sup>th</sup> Agreed betw<sup>en</sup> Richard Knight & J<sup>th</sup> Agreed men the rest of the Co<sup>o</sup> men were now mutually subscribed, sealed &c.

On the 23<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> mo: 1640.

- 1. Tho: Jones & W<sup>illm</sup> Wakefield & that that of Jones was to have had) w<sup>ch</sup> is next adjoining to Bro: Wakefield's lott &c.
- 2. J<sup>th</sup> Agreed againe, y<sup>e</sup> on y<sup>e</sup> 28<sup>th</sup> day of the mo: the waye shall be viewed &c.

On the 28<sup>th</sup> of the 7<sup>th</sup> mo: 1640.

- 1. To John Moulton is granted an acre of meadows (if it may be had) betw<sup>en</sup> the river running by his seat & near the beards &c.
- 2. To W<sup>illm</sup> Easton is granted a rood betw<sup>en</sup> his meadows & y<sup>e</sup> byland &c.
- 3. To M<sup>r</sup> Bartholm<sup>e</sup> (the pastor) is granted an acre of byland & frowne (if it may be had) adjoining to his 4<sup>th</sup> ab of meadow &c.
- 4. To Philemon Dalton Robt Curth, To Sawnderson & James Jarvis is granted a little more of byland (near that of M<sup>r</sup> Bartholm<sup>e</sup>) to set hay on &c.
- 5. To W<sup>illm</sup> Wakefield is granted <sup>or y<sup>e</sup> frowne</sup> ten acres & the Great &c if it be not found in fill &c.
