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The Record of thomas willisis hundred aker lot of land it lys by the harbar Path it is bounded on the west sid by a Marked tree on the west sid of the harbar Path that stands on the hill sid an so Runing 176 Rods in length towards the southwest to sume small swamps : an : it runs in bredgh about fourscore an fortan Rod bounded all Round by marked trees.

The Record of daniell Pearsall hundred aker lot it lys on the Est side of them two : and twenty aker lots where Marvins lot is : it is bounded on the west sid by the hyway between that and the two and twenty aker lots and so Runing Estward a 100 Rods in bredgh and lying 160 Rods in length bounded all Round by marked trees

At a townd Meting Held in Hempsted the sixt day of June in the yeare 1682 it was owned and Concluded by the MaJer Vote of the townd that they have Given Jeremy Hubard a Call to Cume to be minister in this townd

at the foregoing townd Meting it was agreed and Concluded on by the MaJer Vote of the townd that they would Give Mr Jeremy Hubard seventy Pounds a yeare in Currant Pay as it Pasis amongst us for his yearly maintaynance and that he shall have his fire wood brought him a free Cost
