at the foregoing townd Meting it was agreed and Con-Cluded on by the MaJer Vote of the townd that thay would Give Mr Jeremy Hubard seventy Pounds a yeare in Currant Pay as it Pasis amongst us for his yearly maintaynance and that he shall have his fire wood brought him a free Cost
